Our methodology will be informed by lagging indicators of incident frequency and potential severity, but driven by leading indicators of risk control capability and hazard identification.

Our approach to Safety and Health focuses on identifying and characterizing uncontrolled risks, prioritizing gap closure based on potential severity and scope of exposure, and engaging our workers in every aspect of the risk control process.

We commit to protecting the environment by minimizing the impact of our business operations and our products. All our operations are governed by our environmental management system, based on ISO 14001. We will continuously improve and enhance our environmental management system and practices. We will train and educate our employees, suppliers, and vendor partners on our commitment and expectations regarding sustainable resources use and responsible sourcing practices.
